



## From Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA) to Follow Through: Developing Sustainable Behavior Intervention Plans (BIPs) for Escape- and Access-Maintained Behaviors

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This training covers the research and application of differential reinforcement of alternative behavior (DRA) for both escape-maintained and access-maintained behaviors. Case studies bring the research to life and model function-based decision making. The day then shifts into a hands-on session where participants will apply components of the PENT Essential 10 to their own cases with modeling, guided practice, and individualized feedback. Participants will leave with tools to write function-based BIPs for their own cases and practical strategies for building the staff and caregiver buy-in that makes interventions stick.
