



Alternate Pathway to Diploma

An alternate pathway to a diploma is a route that allows students with the most significant cognitive disabilities to earn a meaningful, standards-based high school diploma. In California, this pathway (authorized under California Education Code section 51225.31) modifies the graduation process to be accessible and tailored, rather than lowering expectations.
